MATT AMODIO NOTCHES 33rd ‘JEOPARDY!’ WIN, BECOMES #2 ON ALL-TIME CONSECUTIVE WINS LIST

Amodio’s Winnings Now Total \$1,267,801

CULVER CITY, CALIF. (October 1, 2021) – The “Amodio Rodeo” continues! Matt Amodio, a Ph.D. student from New Haven, Conn., reached another **JEOPARDY!** milestone today when his 33rd victory landed him in second place on the all-time consecutive wins list.

Amodio is in a rarefied position: he is behind only Ken Jennings, who remains in the number one spot with 74 wins.

“Ken’s always been the face of **JEOPARDY!** to me, so when I think of **JEOPARDY!**, I think of him,” Amodio said when asked about Jennings. “To [be] right behind him is a surreal experience.”
